

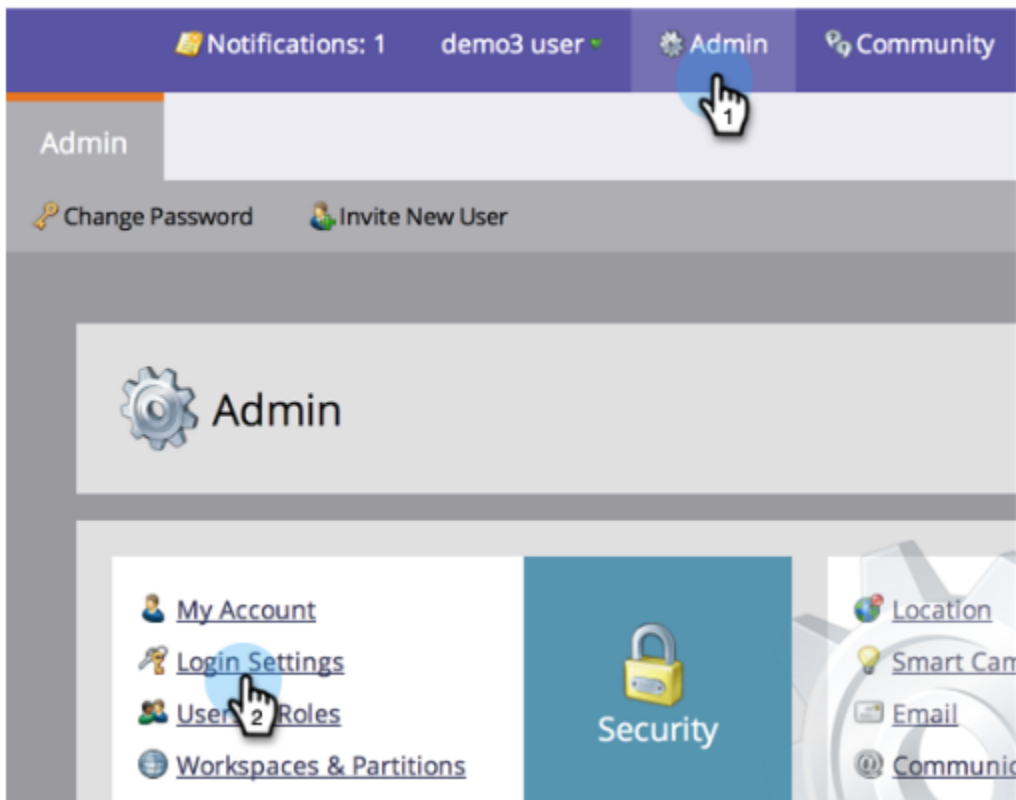
# Restrict User Login to SSO Only

If you're using SSO and want to ensure users cannot bypass the SSO security, follow these instructions.

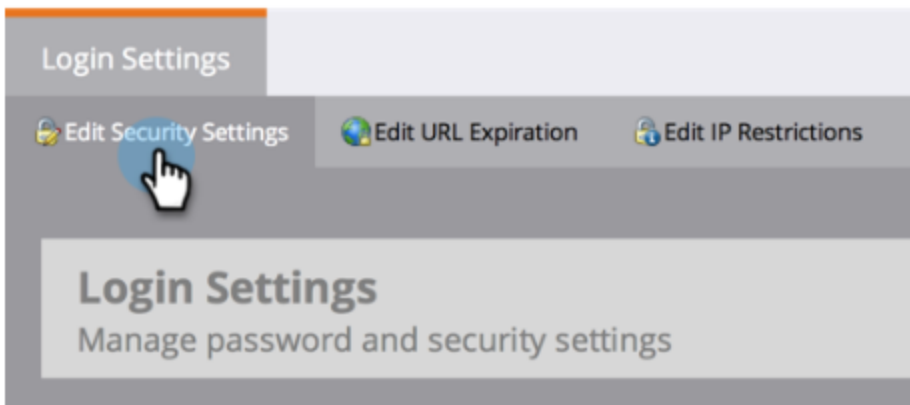


## Admin Permissions Required

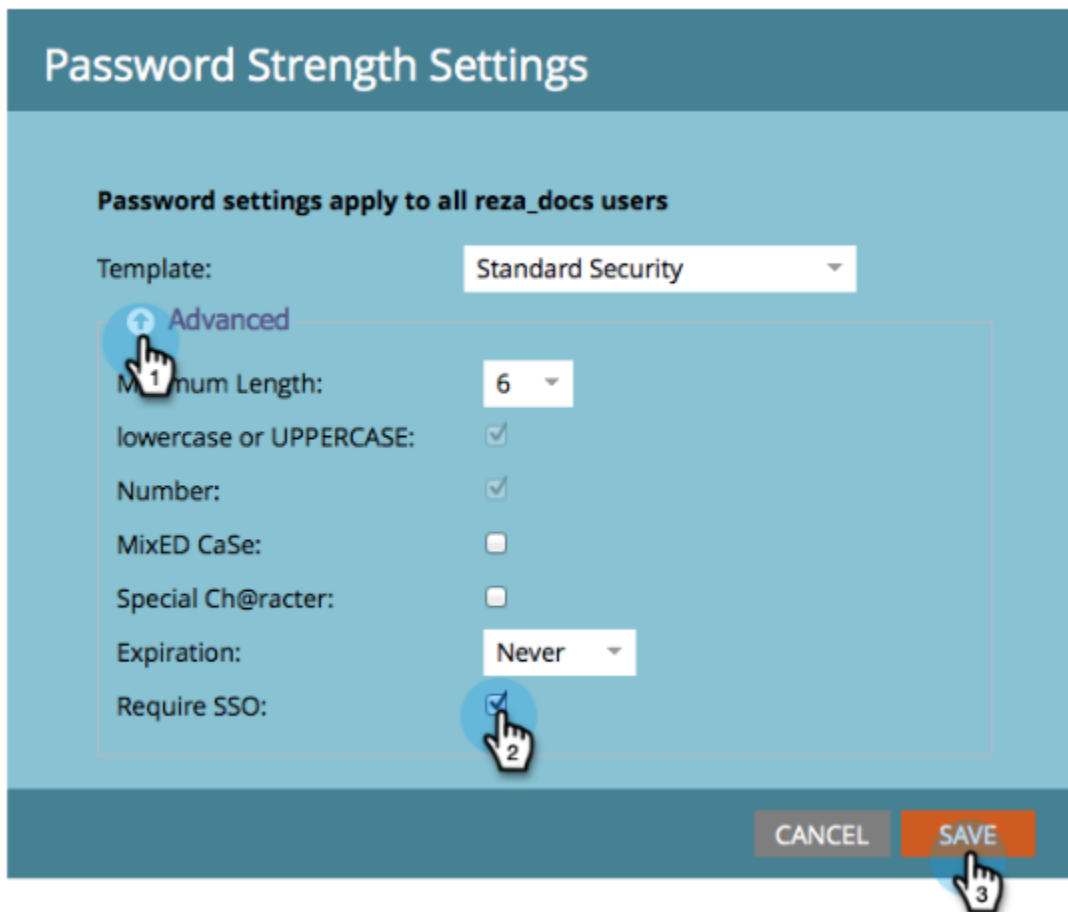
1. Go to **Admin** and click **Login Settings**.



2. Click **Edit Security Settings**.



3. Expand the advanced settings, check **Require SSO**, and click **Save**.



## Tip

If you select **Require SSO**, you can exclude a **user role** from this restriction by checking the **Bypass Single Sign-On** option while setting up the role. This will allow users to sign in normally. For example, Admin users may still need to log into Marketo through the login screen.



## Caution

When new users are invited, they receive invite emails. However, if **Require SSO** is selected, they won't receive these emails, unless they are assigned to a role which is set to **Bypass Single Sign-On**.

That's it! Now all users (except users with permission to bypass single sign-on) will be restricted to using SSO login only.
