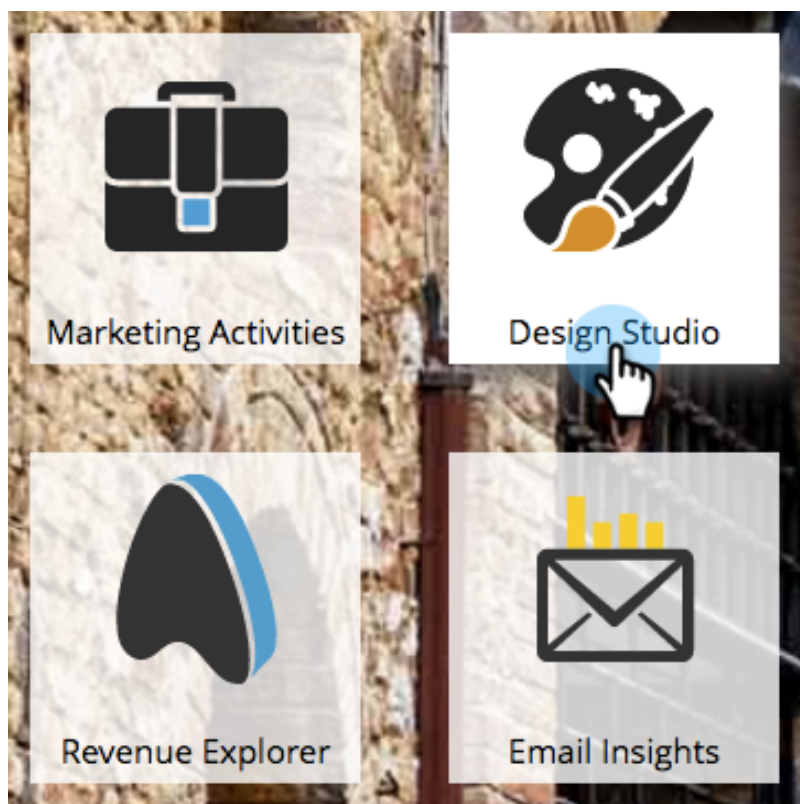


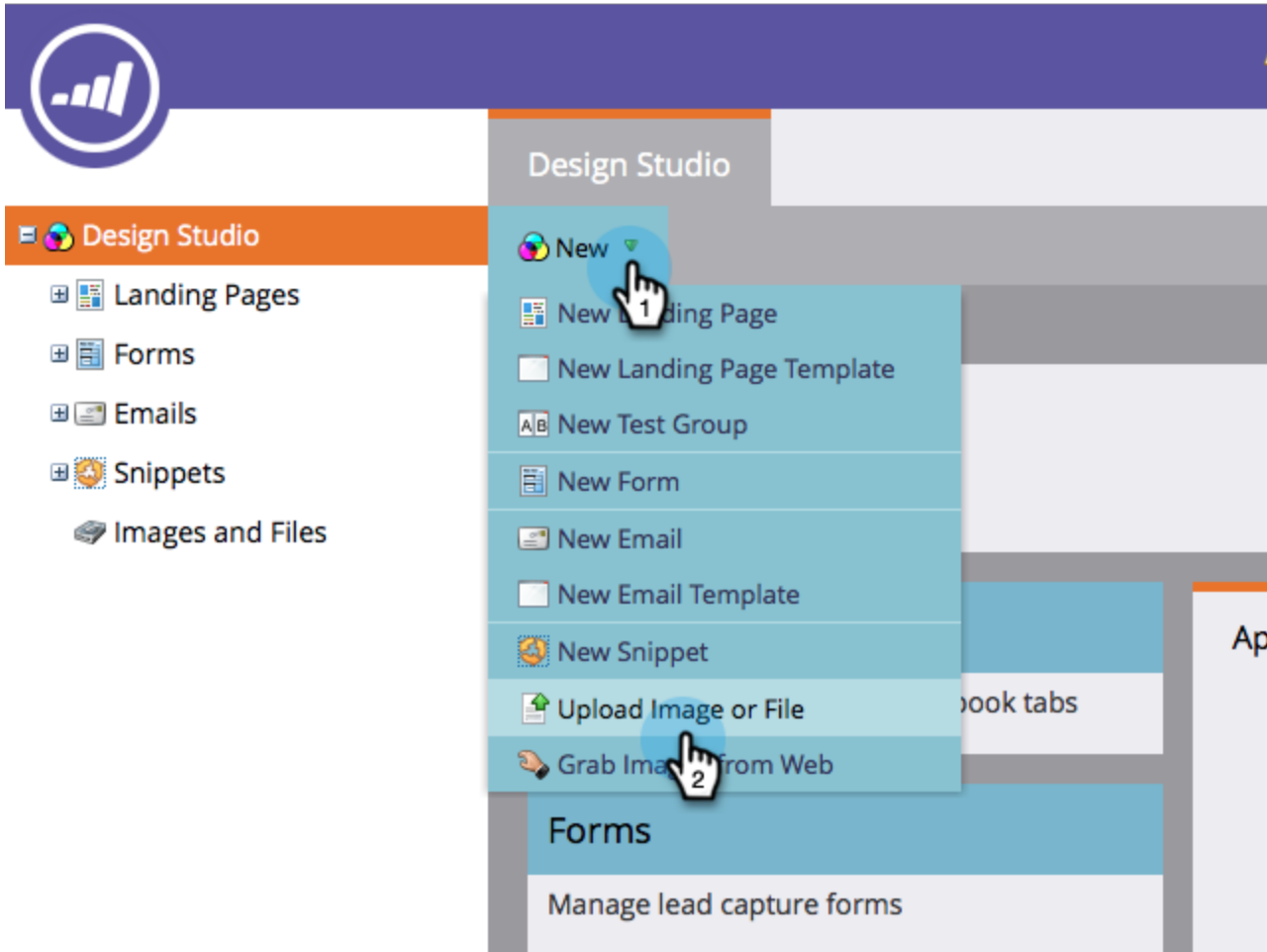
Add Images and Files to Marketo

It's easy to add multiple images and files all at once.

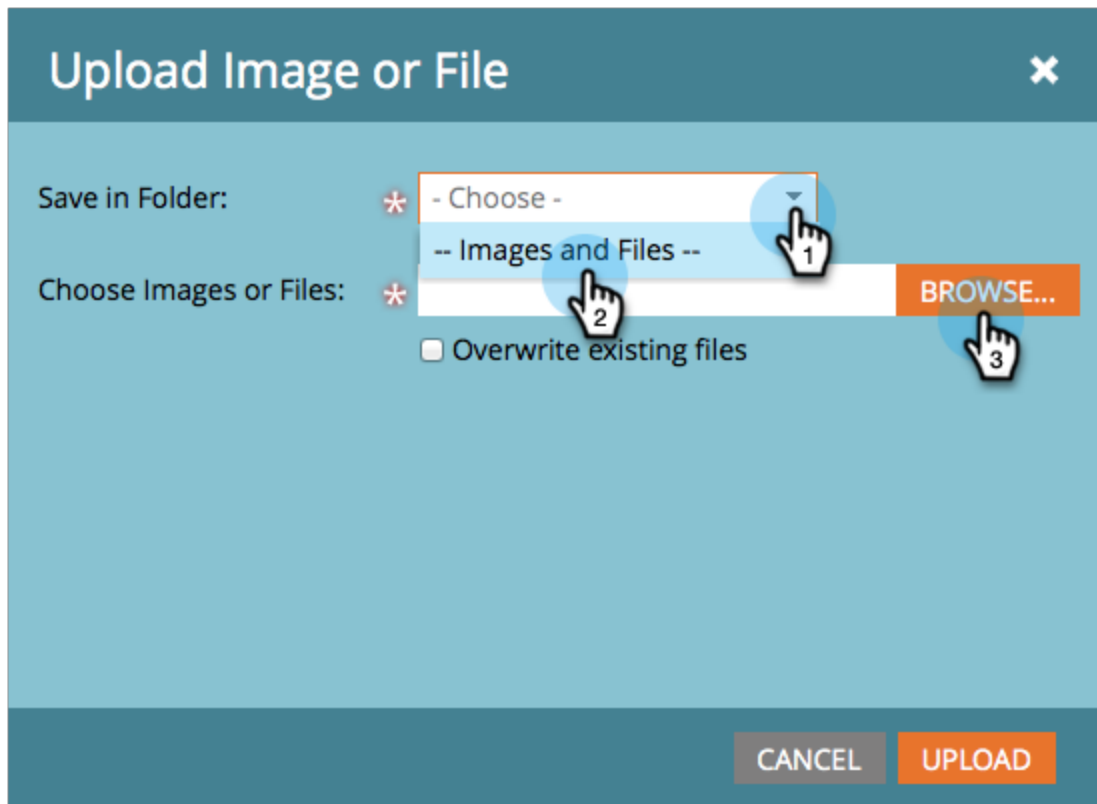
1. Go to the **Design Studio**.



2. Under **New**, click **Upload Image or File**.



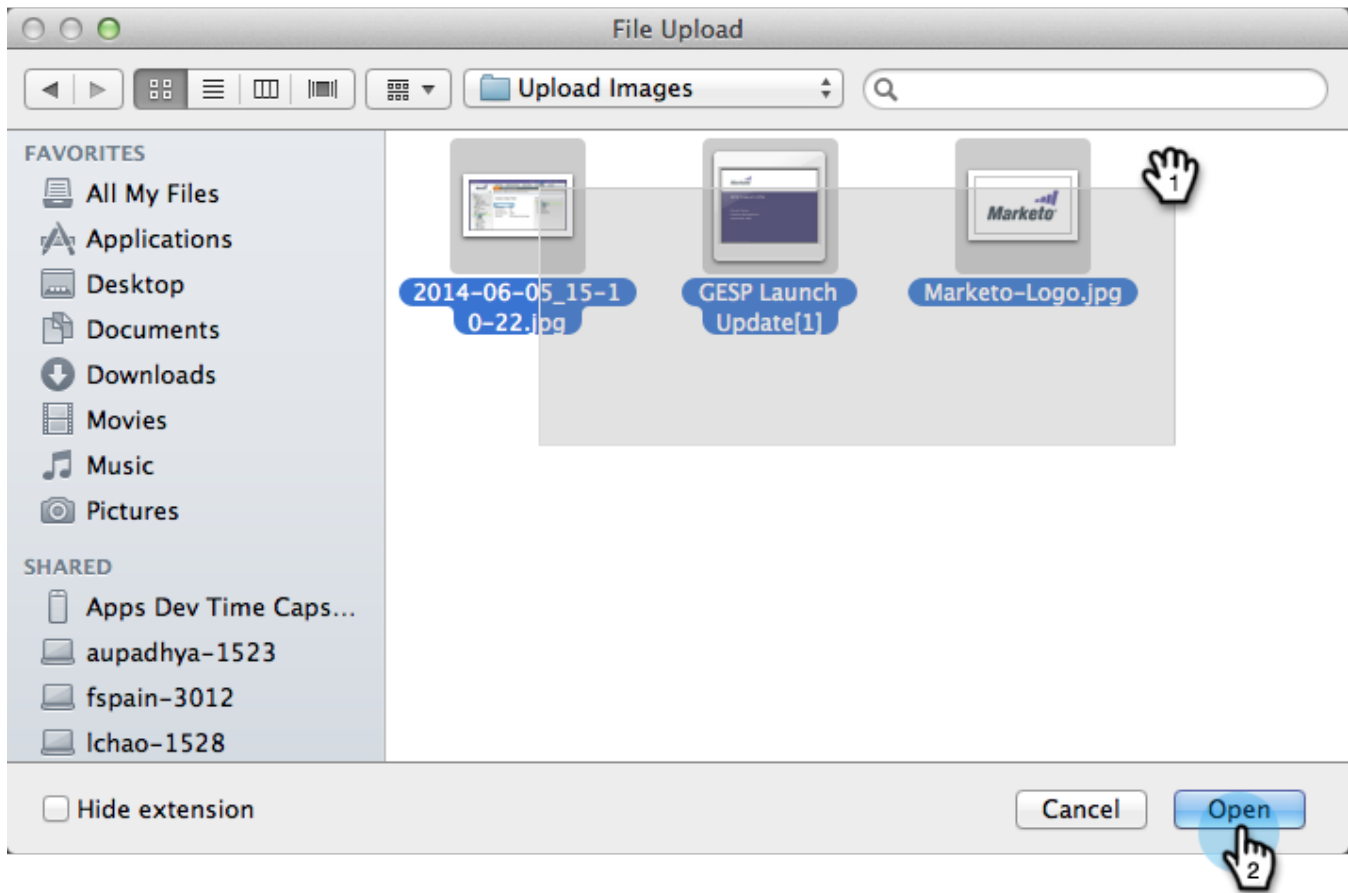
3. Select the folder where you want to store the images or files, then click **Browse**.



Note

The maximum size per file is 100MB.

4. To add multiple images and files, browse to the correct folder on your computer, press **Ctrl/Cmd** and click on each file you want to add, then click **Open**.



5. Expand the **File Details** to verify you selected the correct images, then click **Upload**.
