

Enable No-Draft for Snippets

No-Draft for Snippets allows you to distribute snippet changes without drafting approved assets using it. All assets using the edited snippet get the updates and maintain their respective statuses:

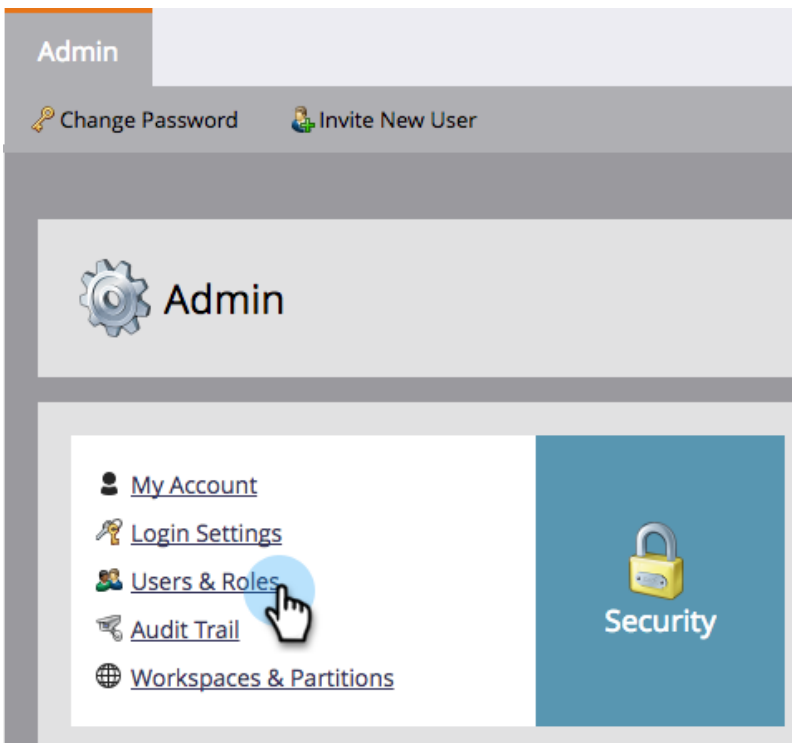
- Approved assets get the snippet updates and stay approved
- Drafts get the snippet updates and stay in draft mode

No-Draft is automatically enabled for all Administrator roles. An admin can then enable this feature for any additional role.



Admin Permissions Required

1. Go to **Admin** and click **Users & Roles**.



2. Go to the **Roles** tab, select a role, then click **Edit Role**.


