


Filter a Campaign Activity Report

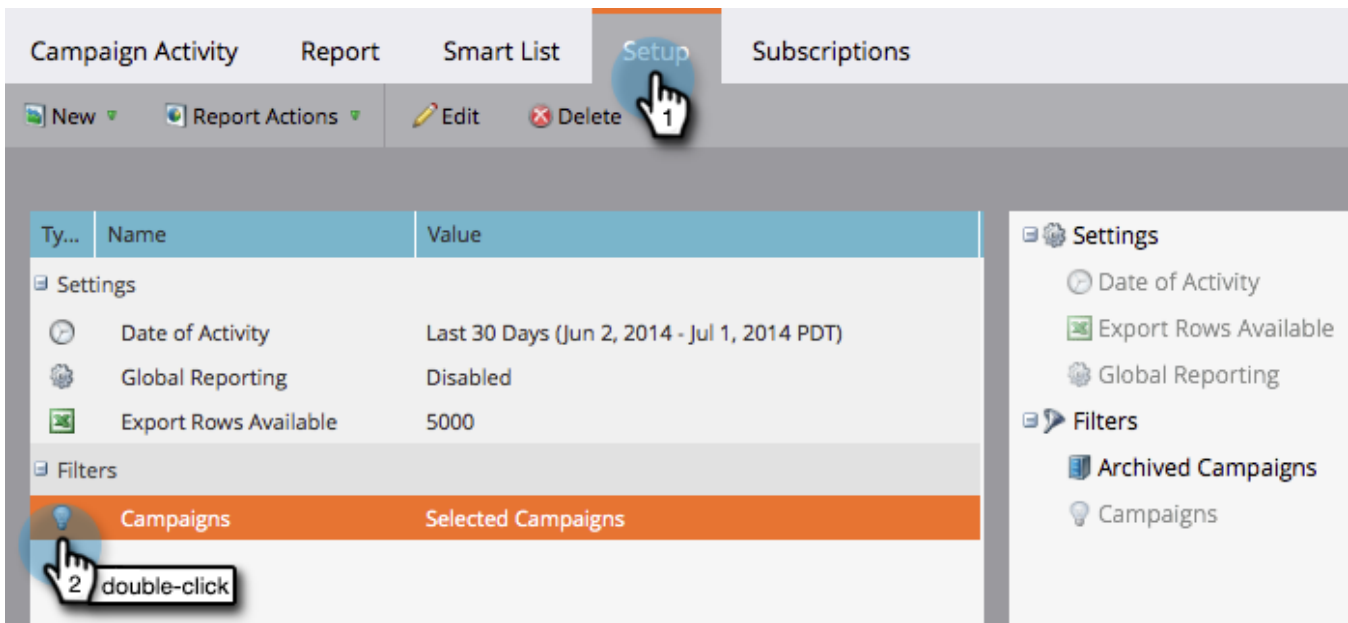
Focus your [Campaign Activity Report](#) on specific [smart campaigns](#).

1. Go to **Marketing Activities** (or **Analytics**) and select your campaign activity report.

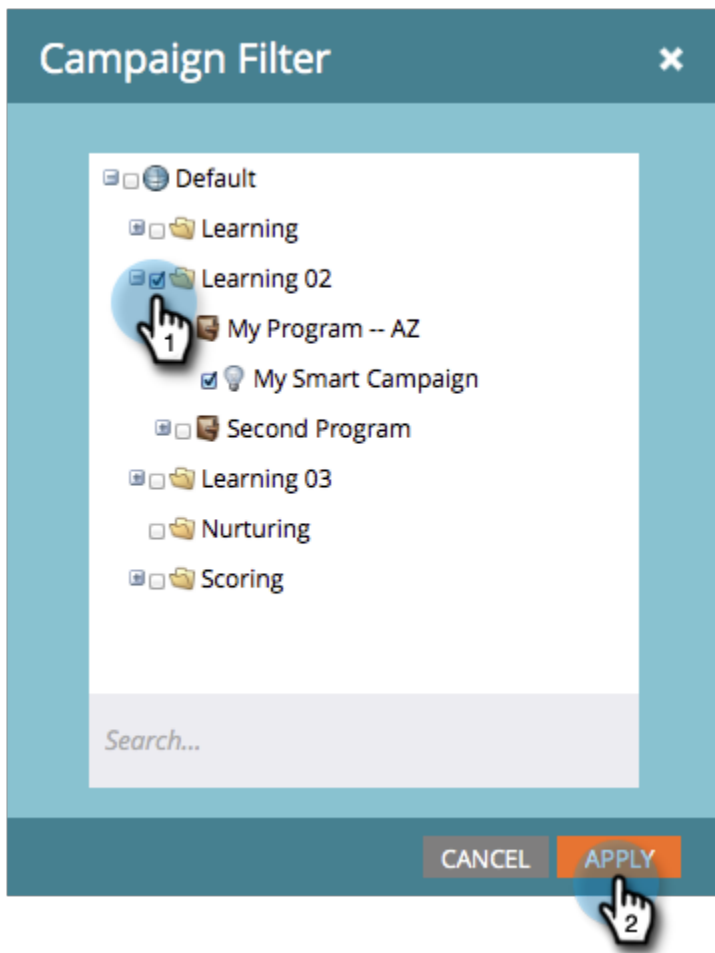

If you select a folder, your report will include everything that folder contains at the time the report runs.

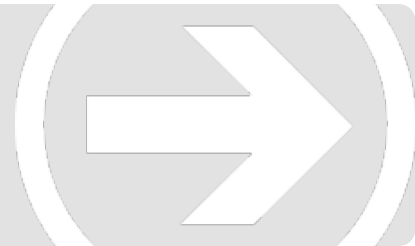


4. You're done! Click the **Report** tab to see *just* the selected smart campaigns in your report.
