

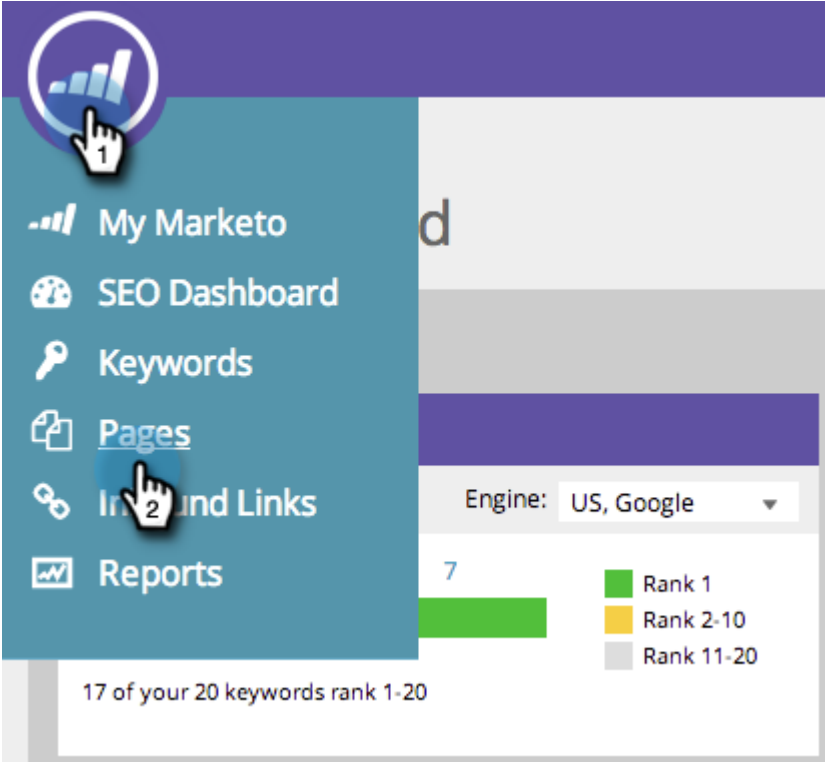

You can organize your page issues into lists. You can also remove page issues from a list.

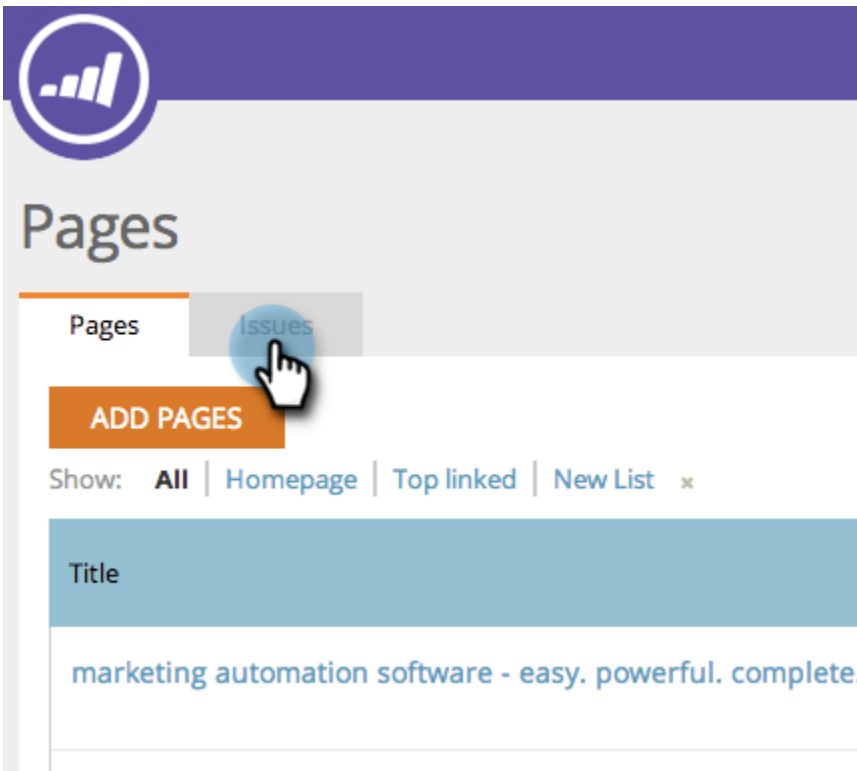

Add Page Issues to a List

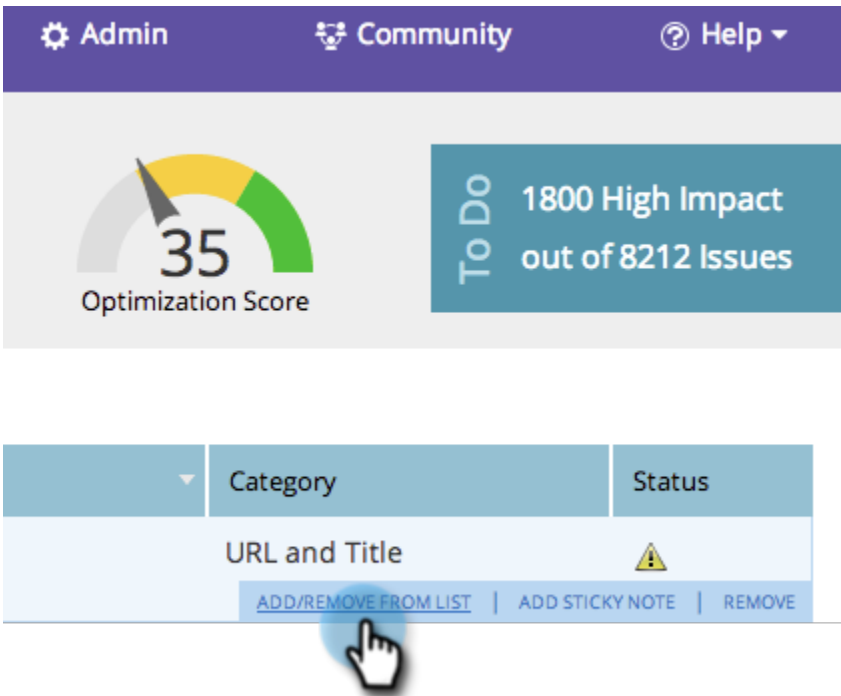
1. Go to the **Pages** section.



2. On the pages tab, click **Issues**.



3. Hover over the page issue you want to add. Click **ADD/REMOVE FROM LIST**.



4. Click on the list you'd like to add your page issue to.

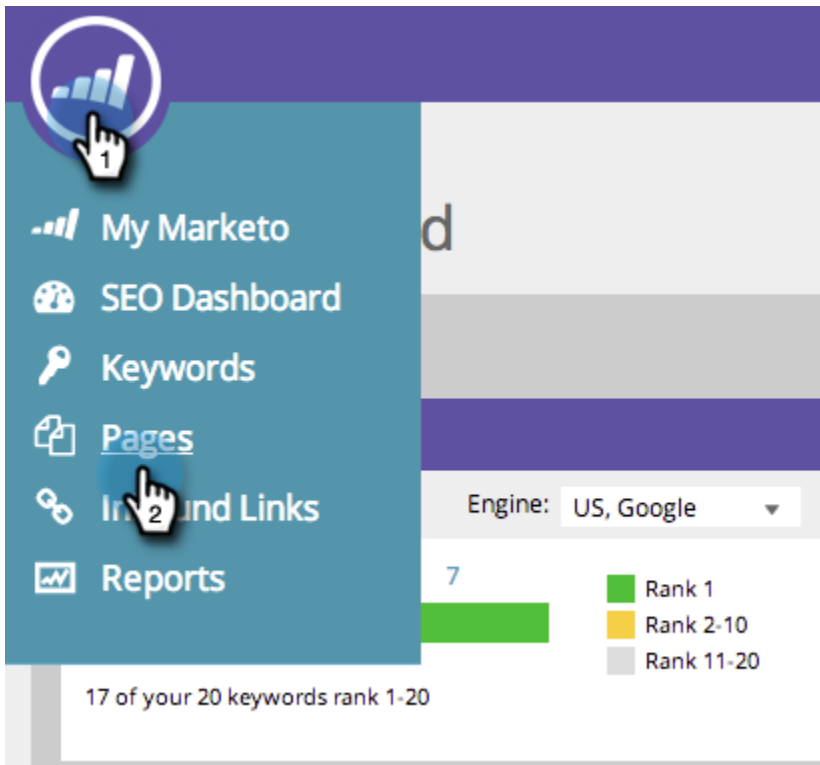

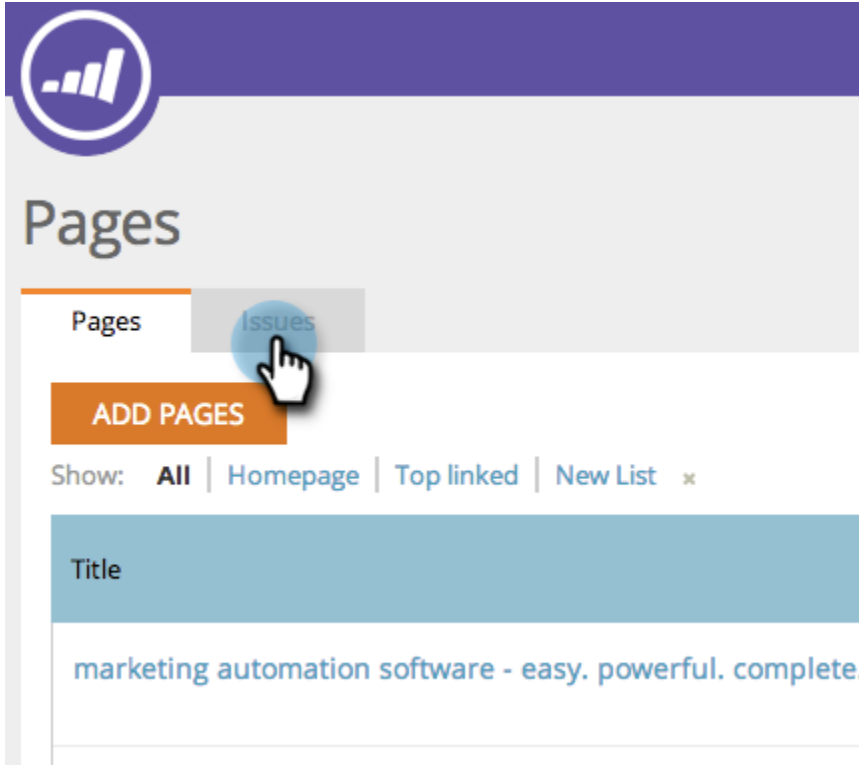
