

Edit a Field

Sometimes you need to edit a field that's not approved yet.

1. Click a custom object and the field you want to edit.




2. On the Fields tab, click **Field Actions** and **Edit Field**.

Delete a Field

When you don't need a field in a custom object anymore, you can delete it.

1. On the Fields tab, click **Field Actions** and **Delete Field**.
